There will be one scholarship awarded for \$1,500 for 2019. If you are chosen to receive a scholarship from the Justin B. Weaver Scholarship committee, you will be awarded \$1,500 to be used in either a basic certification or advanced certification in the trades at any accredited institution for certification. The award will be made directly payable to the trade school or program during the 2019 year.

The scholarship is intended for high school seniors or high school graduates, having graduated between 2016-2019. Applications will be distributed to Waterbury and Thomaston public and private high schools, as well as Naugatuck Valley Community College. The recipient must be a Thomaston or Waterbury resident.
