



### JUSTIN B. WEAVER SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE TRADES APPLICATION 2020

Please note: This application has been partially modified for dates and offerings due to COVID19 impacts over the last few months.

There will be two scholarships awarded for \$1,500 for the Spring 2020-Fall 2020 timeframe. The timeframe for the high school recipient will be for a spring/summer offering and the post high school recipient will be chosen for a fall offering this year. The due dates for high school applicants (seniors 2020) is on June 1, 2020 and August 1, 2020 is the new due date for the post high school applicant.

The recipients will be a high school senior graduating in 2020 (or GED is acceptable) and a postgraduate (graduate prior to 2020 or GED) entering the trades or currently enrolled in a trades program. The certification program can be a basic or advanced certification in the trades, at any accredited institution. Proof of enrollment must be obtained before a check will be awarded to the school. The award will be made directly payable to the trade school or program during the 2020 year.

Information for applicants will also be made available to The Greater Waterbury Area Superintendents' offices for high school seniors to apply and to the area trades programs' offices. The recipient must be a resident of the State of Connecticut.
